

# Pickleball Court Cost Cheat Sheet

**Quick Overview:** Building a pickleball court costs between \$20,000-\$45,000 for outdoor courts and \$50,000+ for indoor courts. Costs vary dramatically based on location, materials, site preparation, and upgrades.

## Key Cost Factors

- Court Type:** Indoor courts cost significantly more than outdoor courts
